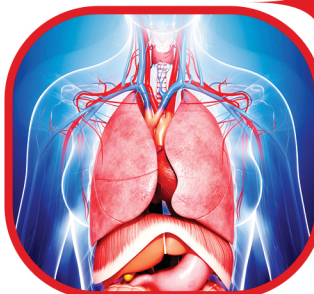
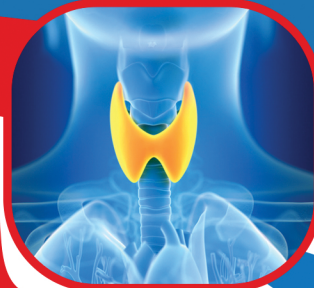

On the day of the screening, you will need to fast for 6 -8 hours prior to the exam. Individuals are allowed to drink water during this period. About 1.5 hours prior to the appointment time, start to drink 32 ounces of water so bladder is full at the start of the exam.

Screening available at no cost every two years for enrolled state plan members employed full-time as a firefighter.

For volunteer/part-time firefighters in CT, a discounted rate is offered.
